
2022 Rat Race Regatta

19 - 20 March

This year, the **2022 Rat Race Regatta** is scheduled to be held on **19th and 20th March** and is open to all boats of the following general classes:

Two Divisions

- Rat Race Division are open to dinghies of less than 5.5m in length including Hartley 16s and 18s under the Australian Sailing Yardsticks handicapping system. (ASYS)
- Stony Point Division is open to trailer-sailers and sports boats which will sail under the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club Mixed Fleet Handicap System. (GRYCMF)



Course directions (clockwise or anti-clockwise) will alternate on each day of the Regatta and will be advised at the Briefing.

Saturday 19th March

- Sausage Sizzle (\$5) will be held from midday,
- Briefing for the first race at 1400.
- The evening meal consists of a barbecue Steak or Chicken, served with salad (please order when completing your online Regatta entry).

Sunday 20th March

- Briefing for the second race at 1000
- followed by a catered Hot Dog lunch (\$5),
- after which the Regatta results will be announced.
